Dear Parents:

Regular kindergarten registration will be held in seven Rincon Valley schools beginning Tuesday, **February 21, 2012**. You may pick up registration packets in your resident school office beginning **February 21**. Please refer to the Registration Process Timeline for your resident school.

At the time of registration, please bring a birth certificate or other evidence of date of birth, as well as your child's "official" immunization records. Your child must receive a physical examination within six months of entry into kindergarten and must be five years old on or before November 1st of the year he/she starts school.

Address verification will be requested in the form of current driver's license or a copy of a utility bill or renter's agreement that shows your current address.

We would like an opportunity to learn more about your child before that exciting first day of school. You and your child are invited to a short interview to be conducted by one of the school's kindergarten teachers. The teacher will talk briefly with your child and observe his/her performance on age appropriate tasks. Please sign up for the interview with the office manager when you return your child's kindergarten registration packet.

For those parents needing Extended Day Care, the district's day care program provides care both before school beginning at 7:00 a.m. and after school until 6:00 p.m. After school day care is on most campuses. Please call your school office or the district office (542-7375, ext. 4113) for more information. 2012-2013 registration forms will be available at each site, the district office, and online (www.rvUSD.org) in April.
